### What are we looking to fund?

#### Projects that are:

- Community-driven and led
- Collaborative
- Problem-solving
- Making a positive change
- Including neighbors from many backgrounds



### Who can apply?

Anybody! If you're not a 501c3, you will need a fiscal agent to contribute in-kind capacity to support the project. But we can help you find one if you need it.



### How much?

Up to \$25K. We have big expectations for those grants but you can request any amount below as well. There is no minimum.



### How long do I have to do the MMH project?

90 days from when the grant is signed.



### What's next?

- Find a passionate leader to spearhead the idea
- Find 3 or more partners to work alongside you (local nonprofits, public institutions, civic groups, neighborhoods, or multiple residents)
- Write-up a quick, three-page proposal that answers the questions in the checklist and explain your idea.
- Send it to DRF via snail mail, email or hand delivery.
- Approval will occur within two weeks of submission.
